Beginning this year, we're replacing 4 miles of natural gas along Washington Street, between 76th Avenue and 105th Place/Washington Way in Thornton, Northglenn and unincorporated Adams County.

Work begins in fall 2022 and continues into 2023. Schedules are subject to change.

## CONSTRUCTION

We work to limit inconveniences to you during our work. As work occurs, you'll notice:

- Utility line marking and utility survey holes.
- Equipment, crews and materials.
- Road and sidewalk restrictions and closures.
- Traffic control.
- Access changes.
- Construction noise.

After installing the natural gas line, we temporarily restore the work area. Final restoration occurs as weather allows, like when it is dry and warm enough. We restore work areas to preconstruction conditions.

Mears is our construction contractor. Additional contractors will work on the project.

## **SAFETY**
